NOTES TO PARENTS OR GUARDIANS

General Notes

- Please use the parking lot at the rear of the church on Brunswick Street each morning to drop off your Camper, and in the afternoon for Camper pick-up. Staff members will be there to escort your Camper into and out of the building safely.
- Please have your Camper dress casually for warm summer weather and light physical activity.
- Please send your Camper to camp each day with a light snack.
- Please let us know if your Camper has any allergies (food or otherwise) that we should be aware of.
- Please let us know if your Camper has any special medical needs or concerns.
- Please let your know Camper know that cell phone use during camp hours is prohibited except in case of an emergency.
- Please try to be on time for daily Drop-off (8:30-9:00 AM) and Pick-up (12:00-12:30 PM).

Snack Time

The most common food allergies are peanuts, tree nuts, milk, eggs, shellfish, seeds, wheat, and soy.

Safe snacks include: vegetables, fruits (including dried fruits), gluten-free and seed-free crackers and cookies. Safe drinks include flavored or unflavored still water or seltzer water.

We will provide cups, plates, napkins and utensils; fresh tap water is available at all times. A kitchen with a refrigerator and a freezer is also available for use by the camp.

Contact Information

There will be one Camp Administrator/Supervisor — someone who is the point of contact between the Parent/Guardian, the Camper, and the Staff, who will be present at the camp every day to receive telephone calls or texts. Their telephone number will be distributed to every Parent/Guardian at least 24 hours before the first day of camp.
